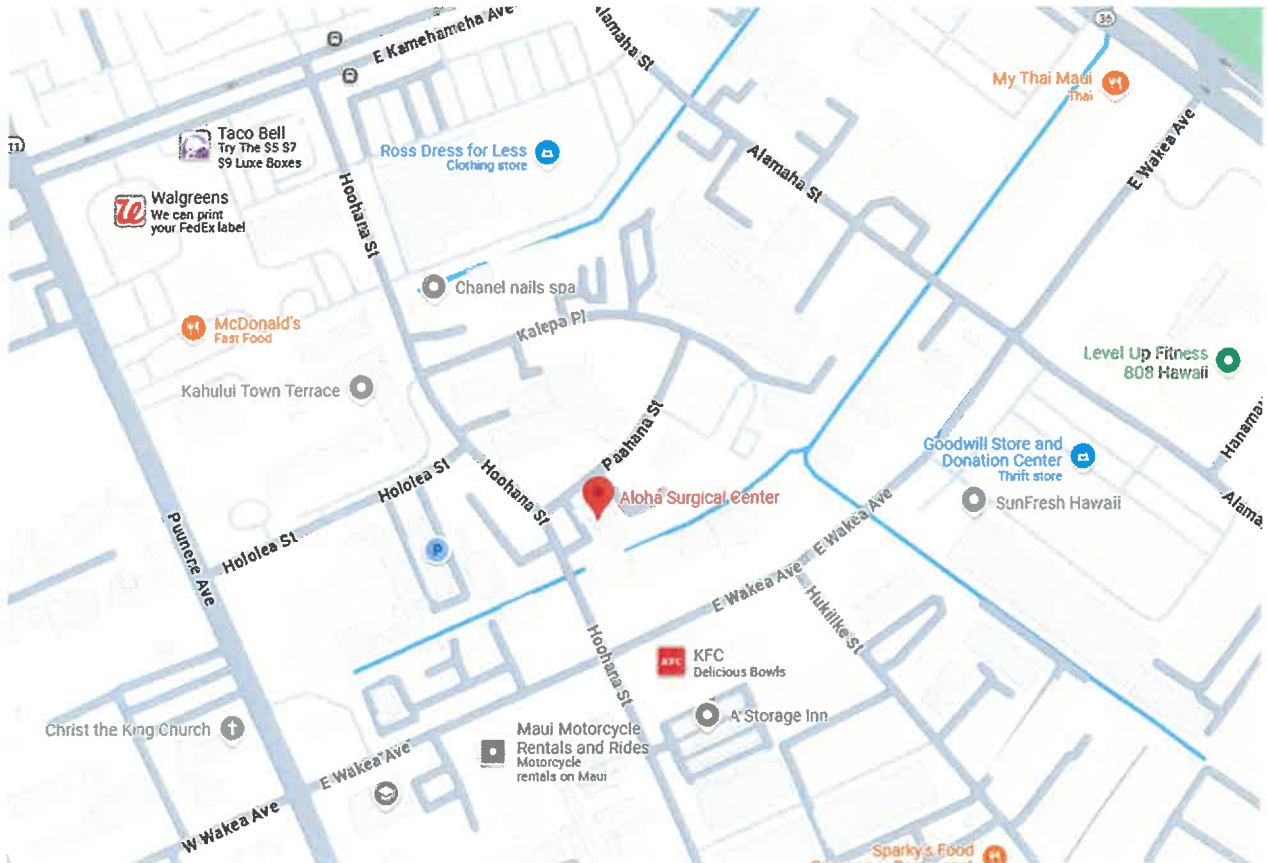
**Please follow the steps below:**

## **IMPORTANT SURGERY PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS**

1. **Arrival Times:** Surgical Dates are scheduled with the Physician's office. Check-in times for surgery are scheduled by Aloha Surgical Center. You will be contacted the business day prior at 9:30am with your check-in time. Please disregard any surgery/check-in times given by your doctor's office. Call (808) 893-0578 ext 102 for questions and scheduling time requests.
2. **EATING AND DRINKING:**
  - a) **Colonoscopy procedures-** In general, **NO SOLID FOOD** starting the day before your procedure. On the day of your procedure **ONLY PREP SOLUTION** and **CLEAR LIQUIDS** are allowed after midnight. Follow Prep Instructions given by your physician, **DO NOT FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS ON THE BOTTLE**. Sips of water with morning medications allowed up to 2 hours before check-in.
  - b) **All other SURGICAL and EGD (Endoscopy)- NO EATING OR DRINKING AFTER MIDNIGHT** the night prior to surgery. Sips of water with morning medications allowed up to 2 hours before check-in.
3. **MEDICATIONS:** Take your usual morning prescription medications unless otherwise instructed by your doctor.
4. **IDENTIFICATION:** Bring your driver's license or ID, insurance card and a method of payment for your co-pay, if applicable.
5. **VALUABLES:** Leave all valuables, including jewelry, at home.

6. **TRANSPORTATION:** You are NOT allowed to drive yourself home after your procedure. At check-in, please give our receptionist the name and phone number of the responsible adult (18+) who will pick you up and drive you home. No Taxi or Uber unless accompanied by a responsible adult (18+).
7. **PATIENTS WITH DIABETES:** DO NOT TAKE ANY DIABETIC DRUGS OR INSULIN THE MORNING OF SURGERY.
8. **Other Preparation:** Do not shave the surgical site. Wash the surgical area well using antibacterial soap.
